Applicant Registration

1. Once you log in, you should see CCIP information at the top of the page.

Applications

The **Credentialed Clinical Instructor Program (CCIP)** is taught throughout the year in both virtual and in-person formats. A list of course offerings with additional course information can be found on the [CCIP webpage](#).

- Courses are public (open to everyone) or private (invitation only).
- Registration for private courses requires a verification code for submission and administered directly by the course coordinator and/or trainer.
- **Course registrations close three weeks before the course start date.**

APTA's Course Registration Fees:

Note: The sponsoring organization may apply additional fees to cover course-related expenses.

Level 1 Course:

- \$100/members
- \$200/nonmembers

Level 2 Course:

- \$100/members
- \$225/nonmembers

If you withdraw within 72 hours of the course start date, you will not receive a refund of the registration fees.

Level 1 Course Manual:

The Level 1 course has transitioned over to an e-manual. Enrolled course registrants will receive an e-mail two days prior to the course start date with instructions on how to access the link to the e-manual. Hard copy manuals are still available, for an additional \$50 fee, up to two weeks prior to the course start date.

CCIP courses are taught throughout the year in both Canada and the United States, and enrollment is open to physical therapists and physical therapist assistants. Successful completion of the course provides physical therapists and physical therapist assistants with 1.6 CEUs and the Clinical Instructor Credential. Health care providers from other professions are eligible to receive 1.2 CEUs, but may not be awarded the Clinical Instructor Credential.
