## CLINICAL CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR INDIVIDUALS OTHER THAN PHYSICAL THERAPISTS AND PHYSICAL THERAPIST ASSISTANTS HOD P06-19-68-32 [Amended: HOD P06-02-26-49; Initial: HOD 06-01-28-28] [Position]

The American Physical Therapy Association expects physical therapists and physical therapist assistants who conduct continuing education courses to identify target audiences and indicate in the printed, lecture, and advertising materials that course content is not intended for use by participants outside the scope of their license or regulation, or contrary to APTA positions, standards, guidelines, policies, and procedures.

The public and profession are best served when organizations take this position into consideration when reviewing, approving, and authorizing activities for continuing education/competence credit.

## **Explanation of Reference Numbers:**

<u>HOD P00-00-00</u> stands for House of Delegates/month/year/page/vote in the House of Delegates minutes; the "P" indicates that it is a position (see below). For example, HOD P06-17-05-04 means that this position can be found in the June 2017 House of Delegates minutes on Page 5 and that it was Vote 4.
