The American Physical Therapy Association recommends education for physical therapists, physical therapist assistants, and students about trauma-informed care to include realizing the widespread impact of trauma; recognizing its signs and symptoms; and responding with policies, procedures, and practices to resist retraumatization of all those with whom we interact, collaborate, and serve.
